

#Caru Amlwch Grant Applications:

Despite being occupiers of the land in question, Amlwch Town Council first became aware of the grant applications following a phone call from Cllr RO Jones on Friday March 17th 2017 indicating there was a complication with the application as the group concerned #CaruAmlwch had failed to obtain permission of the occupier of the land. It became clear that the grant monies would only be released to the Town Council. The Town Council members were anxious that the grant should not be lost and agreed to co-operate with #CaruAmlwch. Had the Town Council not done this the monies would have been lost.

The #CaruAmlwch group were asked to provide details of the proposed suppliers of the equipment. On contacting the suppliers it became clear that the cost of purchasing and siting the equipment was 50% higher than the figures provided by the group. It appears that they failed to take into Account the safety measures required for the equipment and the cost of installing the same.

At the Town Council meeting on the 25th April 2017 it was resolved to fund the shortfall so that the grant was not lost. However in doing so the Council may have to cut other proposed developments in order to remain within budgets as required by the Council's external auditors.
