1 Croeso/Welcome

Cadeiriwyd y cyfarfod gan Gordon Warren ac fe groesawyd pawb oedd yn bresennol. Croesawyd yr aelodau newydd Carys Cranston a Tony Fitzmaurice i'w cyfarfod cyntaf.

The meeting was chaired by Gordon Warren and all present were welcomed. New members Carys Cranston and Tony Fitzmaurice were welcomed to their first meeting

2 Datgan Diddordeb/Declaration of Interest

3 Cofnodion y cyfarfod diwethaf/Minutes of the last meeting

Derbyniwyd cofnodion y cyfarfod yn gywir wedi'r gwelliannau canlynol –

3a (Cyfethol) – wedi trafodaeth, cynnigwyd y gwelliant canlynol gan Liz Wood 'Nododd Richard Griffiths, ar ol siarad a'r swyddog etholaeth ynglyn a'r nifer o ymgeiswyr, bod y swyddog wedi nodi mae'r wybodaeth wedi ei dderbyn gan y Cyngor Tref oedd nad oedd ceisiadau wedi'i derbyn.' Roedd pump o'r wyth aelod oedd yn bresennol yn y cyfarfod gwreiddiol yn fodlon derbyn y gwelliant.

12.4 (Siapio cymunedau) – y gair 'only' i'w ddileu yn y fersiwn Saesneg. Roedd y cyfarfod yn agored i ardal/cylch Amlwch. Mae'r fersiwn Cymraeg yn gywir.

The minutes were confirmed a true record with the following amendments –

3a (Co-option) – Following discussion, Liz Pritchard proposed the following amendment 'Richard Griffiths stated that after talking to the elections officer regarding the number of applicants, the officer stated that the information received from the Town Council was that there were no applicants forward'. 5 of the eight members present at the original meeting were happy to accept the amendment.

12.4 (Place-shaping) – the word 'only' to be removed from the English version. The meeting was open to the Amlwch area/district. The Welsh version of the minutes is correct.

4 Materion yn codi/Matters Arising

4.1 Cyfethol/Co-option

Fe ofynnodd Myrddin Owens beth oedd gan CSYM i wneud gyda cyfethol aelodau newydd gan mai

proses i'r Cyngor Tref oedd hynnu ac i'r Cyngor Tref daw ceisiadau gan rhai a diddordeb rhoi eu henw ymlaen. Mae etholiad fodd bynnag yn fater i CSYM. Nododd Gareth Roberts bod ymchwiliad i'r mater a bydd trafodaeth pellach unwaith bydd mwy o wybodaeth wedi dod i law.

Myrddin Owens asked what involvement IACC had with regard to co-opting members as this was a process for the town Council and applications from interested parties should put their names forward to the Town Council. An election however is a matter for IACC. Gareth Roberts noted that the matter is under investigation and that further discussion will take place once more information is received.

4.2 Cloc y Dref/Town Clock

Cafwyd ddiweddariad gan Liz Wood ynglyn a'r cloc. Mae cyfarfod wedi ei gynnal ar y safle gyda peiriannwr o Smiths of Derby. Mae disgwyl prisiau am drwsio'r cloc; weindiwr awtomatig i'r cloc a weindiwr awtomatig i'r clychau.

Liz Wood gave an update with regard to the clock. A meeting has been held on site with the engineer from Smiths of Derby. Quotes have been requested for the repair, an auto-winder for the clock and an auto winder for the chimes.

4.3 Maes Llwyn

Nododd Richard Jones bod CSYM wedi cymryd bod y Cyngor Tref angen ffens goed o amgylch y tir newydd. Fe gytunodd siarad a'r swyddogion perthnasol fel bod posib symud ymlaen a'r brydles.

Richard Jones noted that IACC has assumed that the Town Council wanted a wooden fence around the new parcel of land. He agreed to speak to the relevant officers so that the lease can be progressed.

4.4 Canolfan Hamdden/Leisure Centre

Nododd Aled Jones bod CSYM wedi gwrthod rhyddhau ffigyrau ariannol ar gyfer y ganolfan gan eu bod yn sensitif. Mae wedi cysylltu a'r adran i gwestiynnau eu penderfynniad. Cytuno cyflwyno Cais Rhyddid Gwybodaeth os na fydd gwybodaeth yn cael ei ddarparu.

Aled Jones noted that IACC have refused to release the financial figures for the centre as of a sensitive nature. He has contacted the department again to challenge their decision. Agreed that a Freedom of Information Request is submitted unless information is forthcoming.

4.5 Age Well

Mae pryderon ymysg aelodau Age Well yn parhau gan fod y grwp yn cael eu gorfodi i symud i'r Ganolfan Hamdden a'r rhesymeg am wneud hynnu. Deallwyd bod y rhent yn y Neuadd Goffa eisioes wedi ei ostwng ar gyfer y mudiad. Mae'r diffyg cyfathrebu rhwng yr ymddiriedolwyr a'r aelodau yn codi pryder; deallwyd bod CSYM yn ceisio trefnu cyfarfod rhwng yr aelodau a'r ymddiriedolwyr. Cytuno gwahodd ymddiriedolwyr Age Well i ddod i siarad a'r Cyngor Tref. Cynnig Gareth Roberts, eilio Liz Wood.

There is still concern amongst Age Well members that the group are being forced to move to the Leisure Centre and the reasoning behind the move. It was understood that the rent at the Memorial Hall had already been reduced for the organisation. The lack of communication between trustees and members is a cause for concern; it is understood that IACC are attempting to facilitate a meeting between the trustees and members to discuss the matter. It was agreed to invite the trustees of Age Well to come to speak to the Town Council proposed Gareth Roberts, seconded Liz Wood.

4.6 Garej Glanrhos Garage

Mae Aled Jones wedi siarad a CSYM ynglyn a pherchnogaeth y safle. Mae adain diogelu'r cyhoedd wedi gofyn i'r adain gorfodaeth cynllunio edrych ar y mater ymhellach. Nid oes gwybodaeth pellach ar hyn o bryd.

Aled Jones has spoken to IACC re ownership. The public health department have asked planning enforcement to look at the matter. There is no further information at present.

4.7 **Pig y Rhos**

Cadarnhaodd Aled Jones bod CSYM wedi cytuno codi arwydd newydd ger y gyffordd.
Aled Jones confirmed that IACC have now agreed to erect a road sign near the junction.

4.8 **Arwyddion Stryd / Road Signs**

Nododd Meg Roberts bod arwyddion ar gyfer Pen y Cefn wedi eu gosod, ond roedd dal i ddisgwyl am arwyddion byngalos Stryd Bethesda a bod trigolion yno yn bryderus nad oedd nwyddau yn cael eu danfon. Cadarnhawyd bod Richard Griffiths yn edrych i fewn i'r mater.

Fe ofynnodd Myrddin Owens pa ddiben oedd cael arwyddion dwy ieithog ble bo'r enw Saesneg yn debyg iawn i'r enw Cymraeg megis Stryd Salem /Salem Street. Cytuno ysgrifennyu at CSYM am eu barn ar y mater.

Meg Roberts noted that signs for Pen y Cefn have been erected however there are still no signs for the bungalows at Bethesda St and residents are concerned that deliveries are not arriving. It was confirmed that Richard Griffiths was looking into the matter.

Myrddin Owens asked what purpose was served by bilingual signs whereby the English name was very similar to the Welsh name e.g Stryd Salem / Sales Street. It was agreed to write to IACC to ask their opinion on the matter.

4.9 **Gardd Goffa/Memorial Garden**

Mae Kevin Ellis wedi cytuno edrych ar berchnogaeth y tir ac mae cyfarfod wedi ei ddrefnu gyda cyfreithiwr yr Eglwys yng Nghymru. Roedd aelodau yn cydnabod bod yr ardal yn rhan o'r fynwent.

Kevin Ellis has agreed to look into the ownership of the land and has a meeting arranged with the provincial solicitor for the Church in Wales. Members acknowledged that the 'oval' formed part of the cemetery.

5 **Aelodaeth Pwyllgorau/Membership of Committees**

Nodwyd bod llefydd gwag ar rai pwyllgorau erbyn hyn gan fod aelodaeth y Cyngor wedi newid. Cadarnhawyd aelodau newydd fel a ganlyn:

Cynllunio – Tony Fitzmaurice (cynnig John Byast, eilio Gina Jones)

Efeillio - Tony Fitzmaurice a Carys Cranston (cynnig John Byast, eilio Gareth Roberts)

Goleuadau Nadolig – Carys Cranston (cynnig John Byast, eilio Myrddin Owens). Nodwyd bod Kevin Ellis eisioes ynghlwm gyda pwyllgor Gwyl Nadolig Amlwch.

Swyddog Llwybrau – Carys Cranston (cynnig Meg Roberts, eilio Myrddin Owens). Gordon Warren i drafod cyfrifoldebau a llwybrau gyda Carys Cranston.

Parciau a Mannau Agored – cytuno byddai Richard Jones yn ymuno a'r pwyllgor tra bod Gordon Warren yn mynychu cyfarfodydd fel Cadeirydd y Cyngor (cynnig John Byast, eilio Liz Wood).

Cyllid - Kevin Ellis a Gerry Belanger i ymuno a'r pwyllgor. Pawb yn gytun.

Cytuno anfon rhestr yn cadarnhau aelodaeth y pwyllgorau gyda'r agenda ar gyfer y cyfarfod nesaf.

It was noted that there were some vacancies in the committees as council members had changed of late. New members were agreed as follows:

Planning – Tony Fitzmaurice (proposed John Byast, seconded Gina Jones)

Twinning – Tony Fitzmaurice and Carys Cranston (proposed John Byast, seconded Gareth Roberts)

Christmas Lights – Carys Cranston (proposed John Byast, seconded Myrddin Owens). It was noted that Kevin Ellis is already involved with the Amlwch Christmas Festival committee

Footpaths officer – Carys Cranston (proposed Meg Roberts, seconded Myrddin Owens). Gordon Warren to liaise with Carys Cranston re paths and responsibilities.

Parks and Open Spaces – agreed that Richard Jones join the committee whilst Gordon Warren attends in his capacity as chair of the Council. (proposed John Byast, seconded Liz Wood)

Finance – Kevin Ellis and Gerry Belanger to join the committee. All agreed.

Agreed to send out a list of updated committee members with the agenda for the next meeting.

6 Pwyllgorau Allannol / External Meetings

6.1 Partneriaeth Cynghorau Gogledd Mon/North Anglesey Councils Partnership

Cadwyd grynodedb gan Gareth Roberts o gyfarfod diwethaf y Bartneriaeth ble gafodd strategaethau rheoli gweithwyr a lletya Horizon eu cyflwyno. Mae'r Bartneriaeth o blaid datblygu safle Rhosgoch ar gyfer lletya gyda datblygiad pellach fel cyfleuster twristiaeth a fyddai yn cynnig cyfleon cyflogaeth i 140-180 o bobl. Fe ofynnodd Gareth Roberts i'r cynghorwyr sirol eu barn am y polisiau cynllunio sy'n ymwneud a Rhosgoch. Mae'n ymddangos bod CSYM wedi rhoi stop ar ddatblygu'r safle mewn pleidlais diweddar. Mae angen trafodaethau pellach i gynnig cyfleon a budd i Amlwch.

Gareth Roberts gave a summary of the last NACP meeting where Horizon's Workers Management and Accommodation strategies were presented. The NACP is in favour of developing the Rhosgoch site as accommodation with further development as a tourism facility providing employment for 140-180 people. Gareth Roberts asked the county councillors their views on the planning policies regarding Rhosgoch. It appears that IACC have put a block on the development of Rhosgoch in a recent council vote. Further discussions are required to provide opportunities and benefit for Amlwch.

6.2 Siapio Cymunedau/Place Shaping

Cafwyd grynodedb gan Liz Wood o'r cyfarfod a gynhaliwyd yn y Neuadd Goffa 31/5/2018. Mae cyfarfod pellach wedi ei drefnu ar gyfer 28/6/2018 yng Ngwesty'r Dinorben. Nodwyd bod y cynllun siapio cymunedau o bosib yn gynladwy ond nad oedd yn dwf economaidd.

Nododd Myrddin Owens ei bryder am y diffyg buddsoddiad yn Amlwch. Mewn cais rhyddid gwybodaeth diweddar i CSYM dangoswyd bod buddsoddiad cyfalaf yn Amlwch yn sylweddol llai na'r buddsoddiad yn Llangefni a Chaerdybi. Cynnigwyd bod llythyr yn cael ei anfon i CSYM i ofyn am gyfarfod i drafod datblygiadau a buddsoddiad posib e.e. tai cymdeithasol, cyflogaeth.

Liz wood gave a summary of the meeting that had taken place at the Memorial Hall 31/5/2018. A further meeting has been arranged for Thursday 28/6/2018 at the Dinorben Arms. It was noted that place shaping may be a sustainable concept but that it was not economic growth.

Myrddin Owens noted his concern regarding the lack of investment in Amlwch. A recent FOI request to IACC showed that capital expenditure in Amlwch was significantly less than Llangefni or Holyhead. It was proposed that a letter be sent to IACC asking for an economic summit to discuss proposed development and investment e.g. social housing, employment.

7 Adroddiad y Pwyllgor Cyllid / Finance Committee Report

Cafwyd grynodedb o'r cyfarfod gan Myrddin Owens. Nododd bod rhestr o daliadau wedi eu cymeradwyo, a bod copi o'r rhestr ar gael i'w weld gan y cler. Nododd bod Gordon Warren wedi cytuno'n garedig i gyfrannu tuag at y gost o gynnal y noson i gefnogi Gruff ym Mhorth Amlwch ar gyfer rownd derfynnol Britain's Got Talent. Nodwyd er bod #CaruAmlwch wedi gofyn am gyfraniad ariannol tuag at y gost o osod offer chwarae, eu bod erbyn hyn wedi diogelu digon o gefnogaeth. Mae adroddiad yr archwiliwr mewnol wedi codi dau bwynt bychain megis bod angen arwyddo bonion yn sieciau yn ogystal a'r siec. Cymeradwywyd y dogfenanu i'w cyflwyno i'r archwiliwr allannol.

Fe ofynnodd Richard Jones beth oedd yn digwydd gyda cais loteri #Caru Amlwch. Cydnabwyd ei fod yn aelod o'r grwp. Byddai Mike Roberts yn rhoi diweddariad ar ran pwyllgor parciau a mannau agored.

Fe adewodd y cler ac aelodau'r cyhoedd y cyfarfod tra bod Myrddin Owens yn rhoi crynodeb o gyfarfod arbennig y pwyllgor cyllid a gynhaliwyd 11/6/2018 yn ymwneud a materion staffio. Dosbarthwyd copi o gofnodion y cyfarfod i rheini oedd yn bresennol er gwybodaeth yn unig.

Myrddin Owens gave a summary of the meeting. He noted that a list of payments were approved, a copy of which can be seen with the clerk. It was noted that Gordon Warren had kindly agreed to contribute towards the cost of holding the event in support of Gruff in Amlwch Port for the final of Britain's Got Talent. It was noted that although #CaruAmlwch had requested financial support for installing play equipment that they had since secured sufficient funds. The internal audit report has raised two small issues such as cheque signatories to also sign the cheque stub. The documents

for the external auditor were approved for submission.

Richard Jones asked what was happening with the #CaruAmlwch lottery grant application. He acknowledged that he was a member of the group. Mike Roberts to provide an update on behalf of Parks and Open Spaces Committee.

The Clerk and Members of the Public left the meeting whilst Myrddin Owens gave a summary of the Extraordinary Finance Committee meeting held 11/6/2018 regarding staff matters. The minutes of the meeting were distributed to those present for information only.

8 Materion Ffyrdd/Highways Matters

Mae Richard Jones a Gerry Belanger wedi edrych ymhellach ar y broblem fod ceir yn anwybyddu arwyddion dim mynediad ym Mhorth Amlwch. Mae'r gyffordd i fewn i dir y Cyngor Tref o'r lon fawr. Mae arwyddion ffordd fodd bynnag yn gyfrifoldeb CSYM.

Nododd Meg Roberts bryderon eto ynglyn a pharcio ym Maes Mona gan nad oedd y mater byth wedi ei ddatrys. Roedd Meg Roberts yn bryderus, er ei bod wedi dwyn sylw'r Cyngor at y mater, ei bod wedi ei chyhuddo o ddweud celwydd am beidio a dod a phryderon yr unigolion at sylw'r Cyngor Tref a a datrys y mater. Nododd Richard Jones nad oedd wedi bod yn ymwybodol o'r gwyn pan fu'n siarad ag un o'r rhai oedd yn cwyno.

Cytuno cefnogi'r cynllunio a Cyflwynwyd gan CSYM ynglyn a gwaharddiadau parcio yn y dref tra yn cydnabod bod angen trafodaeth pellach ynglyn a'r parcio gyferbyn a'r deintydd. Nododd Richard Jones nad oedd am gollu lefydd parcio yn y dref, ond bod CSYM yn bwriadu rhoi palmant 'step out' yn lle'r llinellau gwyn i atal cerbydau rhag parcio ar yr hen gyffordd. Pwysleiswyd mai cerbydau'n cael eu gorfodi i ganol y lon oedd y broblem. Cytuno bod angen i'r Cyngor Tref fod yn ragweithiol yn hytrach nac adweithiol a chytuno bod angen trefnu cyfarfod arall gyda Gordon Warren, Liz Wood, y cynghorwyr sirol a'r swyddogion perthnasol.

Fe ofynnwyd os oedd posib paentio llinellau melyn ger mynedfeydd yr ysgol ym Mhentrefelin a hefyd i'r gwair gael ei dorri ar ymyl y lonydd, yn enwedig ar y cyffyrdd. Mae'r lon i fynu at Pen Cae wedi cau gan ordyfiant.

Nodwyd bod peiriannau O'Connor Utilities (Dwr Cymru) yn ardal Pen Bonc ar adeg gollwng a chasglu plant o'r ysgol ac yn creu problemau gyda cheir wedi parcio a phlant.

Richard Jones and Gerry Belanger have looked in to the issue of cars ignoring the no entry signage in Amlwch Port. The junction is onto Town Council land from the highway. Road signs are however the responsibility of IACC.

Meg Roberts raised concerns again regarding parking at Maes Mona as the matter had still not been addressed. Meg Roberts was concerned that although she had brought the matter up in a Town Council meeting, that members of the public had openly called her a liar for not raising their concerns and the matter being addressed. Richard Jones noted that he had not been aware of the issue when he spoke to one of the complainants.

It was agreed to support all proposals put forward by IACC regarding parking restrictions in town whilst acknowledging that further discussion is required with regard to the parking opposite the dentist. Richard Jones stated that he did not wish to lose parking spaces in the street, but that IACC were looking to place a 'step out' pavement in place of the painted lines to stop vehicles from being parked on the old junction. It was emphasised that the problem was vehicles being forced into the middle of the road. Agreed that the Town Council must be proactive and not reactive and it was agreed that a further meeting be arranged with Gordon Warren, Liz Wood, the County Councillors and relevant officers.

It was asked whether yellow lines could be painted by the school gateways in Pentrefelin, and also for the grass to be cut on the verges especially on junctions. The road up to Pen Cae is nearly totally overgrown from the verges.

It was noted that O'Conner (Welsh Water) machinery were to and from Pen Bonc at school drop off

and pick up times causing havoc amidst parked cars and children.

9 Gwasanaeth Bws/Bus Service

Mae wedi dod at sylw'r Cyngor pa mor annodd ydyw i deithio gyda bws o Amlwch i Langefni ac yn ol. Cytuno ysgrifennu at CSYM i godi ymwybyddiaeth gan na ddylai trigiolion Amlwch gael eu cosbi am drïo cyrraedd y coleg, siopao a gwaith drwy ddefnyddio trafndaieth cyhoeddus.

It has come to the Council's attention how difficult it is to travel by bus from Amlwch to and from Langefni. It was agreed to write to IACC to raise awareness as Amlwch people should not be penalised trying to get to college, shops and work by public transport.

Mae CSYM yn anog adeiladwyr, datblygwyr a pherchnogion tir i adnabod ble gellir adeiladu tai Cyngor ychwnaegol. Nodwyd bod gan CSYM dir yn Amlwch eisioes art gyfer datblygu busnes a thai.

IACC are encouraging builders, developers and landowners to identify parcels of land to develop for additional council houses. It was noted that IACC already own land in Amlwch for both business and housing development.

12.6 Mr W G Davies

Fe ofynnwyd i Mr Davies os oedd ei lythyr yn gwyn swyddogol. Cadarnhaodd ei fod. Fe adewodd aelodau'r cyhoedd a'r clerc y cyfarfod tra bod cynnwys yr ebost yn cael ei drafod.

Cafwyd pleidlais i ddatgan os oedd unrhyw sail i gwyn Mr Davies gan fod y clerc yn dilyn proses cyfredol y Cyngor. Nid yw cofnodion ar gael i'r cyhoedd nes eu bod wedi eu cymeradwyo yng nghyfarfod nesaf y Cyngor.

Nid oedd sail i'w gwyn – yn gefnogol - Gordon Warren, Mike Roberts, Meg Roberts, John Byast, Myrddin Owens, Gerry Belanger, Gareth W Roberts (7 aelod).

Ni fu gwrthwynebiad; Tony Fitzmaurice, Julie Hughes, Liz Wood, Gina Jones, Richard Jones a Carys Cranston (6 aelod) yn atal eu pleidlais.

Mr Davies was asked whether his letter was a formal complaint. He confirmed that it was. Members of the public and the clerk left the meeting whilst the content of the email was discussed.

A vote was taken as to whether there was any foundation to Mr Davies' complaint as the clerk was following current council procedure. Minutes are not made available to the public until ratified at the next council meeting.
