**1 Croeso/Welcome**

Cadeiriwyd y cyfarfod gan Gordon Warren ac fe groesawyd pawb oedd yn bresennol.  
*The meeting was chaired by Gordon Warren and all present were welcomed.*

**2 Datgan Diddordeb/Declaration of Interest**

**3 Comisiynydd Heddlu a Throsedd/Police and Crime Commissioner**

Croesawyd Arfon Jones (Comisiynydd yr Heddlu a Throsedd) a Mark Armstrong (Prif Arolygydd Heddlu Gogledd Cymru) i'r cyfarfod. Diolchodd Arfon Jones am y gwahoddiad i'r cyfarfod gan ymddiheuro nad oedd wedi mynychu ynghynt. Cafwyd grynodedd ganddo o'i gyfrifoldebau a'i amcanion gan nodi ei fod yn atebol i gymunedau lleol gogledd Cymru, gyda'r nod o ddarparu gwasanaeth Heddlu effeithlon ac effeithiol. Amlinellwyd y prif meysydd gwaith a sialensau oedd yn gwynebu'r Heddlu ar hyn o bryd.

Diolchwyd i Arfon Jones am ei gyflwyniad. Nododd Meg Roberts bod pryderon wedi eu nodi gyda'r Heddlu yn y gorffennol am y ffordd mae'r gwasanaeth yn cael ei gynnal ond nad unrhyw beth wedi digwydd na newid. Nodwyd nad oedd derbynydd llawn amser yng ngorsaf yr Heddlu yn Llangefni, ac mai dyma oedd prif hwb yr Heddlu ym Mon? Nid oes celloedd ym Mon mwyach ac felly mae heddweision yn gorfod gadael yr ynys unwaith bod ganddynt rhywun yn eu meddiant. Nodwyd nad oedd cyfleusterau Mon yn cyrraedd safonau ac felly nad oeddent yn gallu cael eu defnyddio. Gosodir y safonau yma gan y Swyddfa Gartref er mwyn sicrhau na fyddai unrhywun yn marw tra yng ngofal yr Heddlu.

Nodwyd bod gwasanaeth yr Heddlu yn fwy na heddweision, a bod grwp #Caru Amlwch yn ddiweddar wedi derbyn gwobr am waith gyda phobl ifanc. Trafodwyd y posibilrwydd o ehangu gwaith gwirfoddol, gan gydnabod byddai well i heddweision ddelio a throeseddau yn hytrach nac eistedd y tu ol i ddesg. Nodwyd hefyd bod llawer o waith i godi ymwybyddiaeth a diogelu pobl yn ogystal ac ymladd troseddau. Cafwyd wybod gan Mark Armstrong bod y nifer o droseddau yn cael eu cofrestru gyda'r heddlu yn cynyddu, ond bod rhaid i'r heddweision ganolbwyntio ar yr achosion mwyaf.

Fe ofynnodd Myrddin Owens i Arfon Jones os oedd yn hapus a'r nifer o swyddogion oedd yn gallu

siarad Cymraeg. Mewn ymateb nododd Mr Jones y byddai'n fuddiol cael llawer iawn mwy o heddweision oedd yn gallu'r Gymraeg. Mae llawer yn gallu'r Gymraeg on ddim yn hyderus. Nododd ei fod yn edrych ar ffyrdd o gynyddu'r nifer sydd yn defnyddio'r Gymraeg, a bod gwaith yn mynd yn ei flaen i geisio gwella'r system a'r gwasanaeth a gynnigir. Nododd Gareth Roberts fod y dref wedi bod yn lwcus iawn gyda'r heddweision sydd yn gweithio yng ngorsaf Amlwch.

Fe ofynnodd Gareth Roberts am ddiweddariad gan yr Heddlu ynglyn a thrafodaethau gyda Horizon am ddatblygiad Wylfa Newydd. Nodwyd bod yr Heddlu wedi bod yn trafod gyda'r cwmni ers pedair mlynedd bellach ond yn dal i ddisgwyl am ymateb beth a gawn i'r ardal.

Diolchwyd i Arfon Jones a Mark Armstrong am eu hamser i gwrdd a'raelodau.

*Arfon Jones (Police and Crime Commissioner) and Mark Armstrong (Chief Inspector, North Wales Police) were welcomed to the meeting. Arfon Jones thanked the Council for the invitation and apologised that he had not been able to attend sooner. He gave an overview of his responsibilities and objectives, noting that he was answerable to the local communities of North Wales, with the aim of providing an effective and efficient police service. The main areas of work and challenges facing the police at present were outlined*

*Arfon Jones was thanked for his presentation. Meg Roberts noted that concerns had been raised with the Police in the past about the way in which the service is managed but no action had been taken or changes made. It was noted that there was no full time receptionist at the Llangefni Station and that this was the main police hub on Anglesey? There are no cells on Anglesey anymore and as such police officers have to leave the island as soon as they have someone in custody. It was noted that the facilities on Anglesey no longer reached specific standards and therefore could not be used. The standards are set by the Home Office in order to ensure that there are no deaths whilst in police custody.*

*It was noted that the Police service was far more than police officers and that #Caru Amlwch group had recently received an award for work with young people. The possibility of extending volunteer work was discussed, acknowledging that it would be better for police officers to be tackling crimes rather than sitting behind a desk. It was also noted that a fair amount of work to raise awareness and safeguard people as well as tackling crimes. Mark Armstrong noted that the number of offences reported to the police had increased, but that the police officers had to concentrate on the major crimes.*

*Myrddin Owens asked Arfon Jones if he was happy with the number of officers who were able to speak Welsh. In response Mr Jones noted that it would be of benefit to have many more officers that were able to communicate in Welsh. Many are able to speak Welsh but lack confidence to do so. He is looking at ways in which to increase the number making use of the language, and work is ongoing to improve the system and the service offered. Gareth Roberts noted that the town had been very lucky with the officers working from the station in Amlwch.*

*Gareth Roberts asked for an update from the Police with regard to the discussions with Horizon regarding the development of Wylfa Newydd. It was noted that the Police have been in discussions with Horizon for four years but still waiting on a response as to what the area will gain.*

*Arfon Jones and Mark Armstrong were thanked for their time to meet with the Members.*

#### **4 Cofnodion y cyfarfod diwethaf/Minutes of the last meeting**

Derbyniwyd cofnodion y cyfarfod yn gywir. Cynnig Myrddin Owens, eilio Gareth Roberts. The minutes were confirmed a true record. Proposed Myrddin Owens seconded Gareth Roberts.

#### **5 Materion yn codi/Matters Arising** **5.1 Cyfethol/Co-option**

Er bod gwelliannau wedi eu derbyn i'r cofnodion (Mai) yn y cyfarfod diwethaf (Mehefin), nodwyd bod angen ychwanegu i'r gwelliant diwethaf sef 'Nododd Richard Griffiths, ar ol siarad a'r swyddog etholaeth ynglyn a'r nifer o ymgeiswyr, bod y swyddog wedi nodi mae'r wybodaeth wedi ei dderbyn gan y Cyngor Tref oedd nad oedd ceisiadau wedi'i derbyn.' Nodwyd bod angen ychwanegu bod Richard Griffiths hefyd wedi siarad ag Arweinydd y Cyngor yn Llangefni ac yn ymwybodol o pump

enw arall oedd i'w rhoi ymlaen. Pawb yn bresennol yn cytuno. Nodwyd bod cyfenw Liz Wood wedi ei gofnodi yn anghywir yn y Saesneg.

*Although the minutes (May) had been amended at the last meeting (June) as follows - 'Richard Griffiths stated that after talking to the elections officer regarding the number of applicants, the officer stated that the information received from the Town Council was that there were no applicants forward', it was noted that the following should also be included in the amendment - Richard Griffiths had spoken to the Leader of the Council in Llangefni and was aware of five other names that were to be put forward. All present in agreement. Noted that the Liz Wood's surname had been incorrectly minuted in English.*

## **5.2 Cloc y Dref/Town Clock**

Nododd Liz Wood bod pris wedi ei dderbyn am y gwaith ond bod angen eglurhad pellach.

*Liz Wood noted that a quote had been received for the work but further clarification was required.*

## **5.3 Maes Llwyn**

Deallwyd bod yr Adran Dai CSYM yn disgwyl am bris ar gyfer y gwaith ffensio cyn dod i gytundeb ffurfiol.

*It was understood that the Housing dept. IACC were waiting on a quote for the fencing work before coming to a formal agreement.*

## **5.4 Canolfan Hamdden/Leisure Centre**

Nododd Aled Jones ei fod wedi anfon gwybodaeth pellach ymlaen i'r Swyddfa drwy ebost. Cytuno cynnwys yr eitem ar agenda'r cyfarfod nesaf.

*Aled Jones noted that he had forwarded additional information to the Town Council Office by email. Agreed to include the item on the agenda of the next meeting.*

## **5.5 Age Well**

Daw ebost gan y grwp mewn ymateb i'r gwahoddiad am gyfarfod. Nododd Julie Hughes ei bod wedi siarad gyda un o ymddiriedolwyr y Neuadd a'u bod yn awyddus cael cyfarfod. Cytuno cynnwys yr eitem ar agenda'r cyfarfod nesaf.

*An email was received from the group in response to an invitation to meet. Julie Hughes noted that she had spoken to one of the Hall's trustees and that they were eager to meet. Agreed to include the item on the agenda for the next meeting.*

## **5.7 Garej Glanrhos Garage**

Mae Aled Jones wedi gwneud ymholiadau ac wedi anfon gwybodaeth ymlaen i'r Swyddfa. Teimlwyd bod y safle yn parhau i fod yn beryg. Awgrymodd Gareth Roberts bod gofyn i'r Adran Gyfreithiol CSYM wirio pwy oedd berchen ar y safle.

*Aled Jones has made enquiries and forwarded information to the Town Council Office. The site is still deemed a danger/hazard. Gareth Roberts suggested that contact be made with IACC Legal dept. to determine the site ownership.*

## **5.8 Pig y Rhos**

Mae CSYM wedi cytuno gosod arwydd ar y lon ac angen cadarnhad o'r enw. Pawb yn cytuno ar 'Pig y Rhos' neu 'Lon Pog y Rhos'.

*IACC have agreed to a sign on the road and wanted confirmation on the name. All agreed on 'Pig y Rhos' or 'Lon Pig y Rhos'.*

## **5.9 Siapio Cymunedau/Place Shaping**

Nododd Myrddin Owens bod buddsoddiad yn Amlwch yn sylweddol llai na buddsoddiad yn Llangefni na Chaergybi ac fe ofynnodd i'r cynghorwyr sirol am ddiweddariad. Nododd Aled Jones ei

fod wedi codi'r pwynt yn y cyfarfod diwethaf ac wedi cael gwybod nad oedd tir ar gael i'w ddatblygu. Nodwyd bod tir wedi ei glustnodi ar gyfer diwydiant yn Amlwch. Cytuno gofyn i'r ddau gynghorwr arall gan eu bod yn aelodau o'r grwp rheoli sy'n gwneud penderfyniadau. Dylai swyddogion yn Llangefni wybod bod tir yn Amlwch a ble mae wedi ei leoli.

Nododd Carys Cranston bod y gweithdy siapio cymunedau wedi cael cefnogaeth dda a gobeithiai bydd yr adroddiad yn adnabod syniadau i'w datblygu. Roedd Meg Roberts yn bryderus bod y Cyngor Tref yn cael ei feirniadu yn y gweithdai am wrthod datblygiad siop Aldi yn Amlwch. Nododd bod y Cyngor wedi gwahodd amryw o siopao tebyg i'r dref heb lwc. Cadarnhaodd Aled Jones ei fod wedi ysgrifennu at Aldi a nad oedd ganddynt ddiddordeb.

Cytuno gwahodd Pennaeth Cynllunio a Datblygiad Economaidd i'r cyfarfod Cyngor Tref nesaf. Pawb yn cytuno.

*Myrddin Owens noted that investment in Amlwch was significantly less than Holyhead and Llangefni and asked the County Councillors for an update. Aled Jones stated that he had raised the point at the last meeting and was told no land was available for development. It was noted that land had been earmarked for industry in Amlwch. Agreed to ask the other two councillors as they are members of the decision-making ruling group. Officers in Llangefni should know that there is land in Amlwch and where it is located.*

*Carys Cranston noted that the place shaping workshop had been well supported and it was hoped that the report would identify some ideas put forward. Meg Roberts was concerned that the Town Council were being criticised at the workshops for refusing the development of Aldi in Amlwch. She confirmed that the Council have tried to entice various other such stores to the town with no luck. Aled Jones confirmed that he had written to Aldi and that they had no interest.*

*Agreed to invite Head of Economic and Planning to the next Town Council meeting. All in agreement.*

#### **5.10 Partneriaeth Cynghorau Gogledd Mon/North Anglesey Council Partnership**

Fe ofynnodd Carys Cranston pwy oedd ynghlwm a'r corff yma, a phwy oedd yn cynrychioli Cyngor Tref Amlwch. Nodwyd bod chwe Cyngor tref a Chymuned Gogledd Mon wedi eu cynrychioli arno, gyda Myrddin Owens a Gareth Roberts yn cynrychioli Amlwch.

*Carys Cranston asked who was involved with this organisation and who represented the Town Council. It was noted that the six Town and Community Councils of North Anglesey are represented, with Gareth Roberts and Myrddin Owens representing Amlwch.*

#### **5.11 Parcio Stryd Salem Parking**

Yn dilyn cyfarfod ar y safle, mae wedi cytuno dileu dau le parcio gyferbyn a'r deintydd, a dileu'r gwaharddiad parcio anabl ar ddau le parcio tu allan i'r hen swyddfa bost.

*Following a meeting on site it has been agreed to remove two parking spaces opposite the dentist and remove the disabled restrictions on two parking spaces by the old post office.*

#### **6 Pwyllgorau Allanol / External Meetings**

Dosbarthwyd adrioddiad gan Gordon Warren yn amlinellu'r cyfarfodydd yr oedd wedi ei fynychu ers y cyfarfod Cyngor diwethaf. Un Llais Cymru 20/6/2018, Gweithdy Siapio Cymunedau CSYM 5/7/2018, Cyfarfod Blynyddol Age Well 18/7/2018.

*Gordon Warren distributed a short report outlining the meetings he had attended since the last Council meeting. One Voice Wales 20/6/18, IoACC Place Shaping Workshop 5/7/18, Agewell AGM 18/7/18.*

#### **7 Adroddiad y Pwyllgor Cyllid / Finance Committee Report**

Cafwyd grynodedb o'r cyfarfod gan Myrddin Owens. Nodwyd am resymau iechyd a diogelwch, bod y gwaith i osod camera a chlo ychwanegol ar ddrws mewnol y swyddfa yn mynd yn ei flaen. Mae'r Pwyllgor Cyllid yn cynnig bod y Cyngor yn prynnu offer recordio i'w ddefnyddio yng nghyfarfodydd y Cyngor. Roedd pawb yn bresennol yn cytuno.

*Myrddin Owens gave a summary of the meeting. It was noted that in line with health and safety, the work to install a camera and additional lock on the office partition door was going ahead. The Finance Committee proposed that the Council purchase recording equipment to be used at Council meetings. All present were in agreement.*

## **8 Adroddiad Parciau a Mannau Agored/Parks and Open Spaces Report**

Nododd Mike Roberts nad oedd adroddiad ysgrifenedig ond bod cofnodion y cyfarfodydd ar gael er gwybodaeth. Mae'r pwyllgor wedi cytuno cwrdd pob yn ail mis, gydag aelodau yn cymryd cyfrifoldeb am adrodd yn ol ar wahanol ardaloedd.

Mae Mike Roberts wedi cwrdd a chynrychiolwyr o gynghorau Rhosybol a Llanelian ynglyn a gweithio mewn partneriaeth ar gyfer prosiect Mynydd Parys 250. Mae Gordon Warren a Mike Roberts yn trafod gyda #Caru Amlwch ynglyn a'r cais am arian loteri. Nododd Kevin Ellis bod y dyddiad cau ar gyfer y cais ym mis Tachwedd, cytuno cynnwys yr eitem ar yr agenda ar gyfer cyfarfod mis Medi; Mike Roberts i edrych ar goblygiadau'r Cyngor a pharatoi adroddiad i'r Cyngor.

Mae gwaith wedi ei gwblhau ym mharc Lon Wen, Porth Amlwch, cafwyd prisiau am y gwaith a'i gwblhau ar fryder o ganlyniad i bryderon iechyd a diogelwch. Cafwyd grynodedeb gan Mike Roberts am drafodaethau gyda #Caru Amlwch ynglyn a'r offer chwarae arfaethiedig ar gyfer Craig y Don.

Mewn perthynas a grant posib ar gyfer Maes Mona, daw pryder gan berchenog ty cyfagos; fodd bynnag mae cefnogaeth helaeth gan eraill. Cynnigwyd bod yr ardal yn cael ei ddynodi i blant ifanc cyn eu harddegau.

Gofynnodd Meg Roberts am ddiweddariad ynglyn a meinciau ger y 'Creek; mae'r mater o berchnogaeth tir a chyfrifoldebau wedi ei drafod gan Mike Roberts a'r clerch.

Mae Mike Roberts wedi cwrdd a'r contractiwr torri gwair; mae ysbwriel a thipio anghyfreithlon yn parhau yn broblem; mae peiriannwr coed wedi ymweld a Threhinion i asesu'r coed sydd wedi disgyn, mae' risg yn isel iawn.

*Mike Roberts noted that there was no written report but that minutes of the meetings are available for information. The committee have agreed to meet on a bimonthly basis, with members taking responsibility for reporting on specific areas.*

*Mike Roberts has met with representatives from both Rhosybol and Llanelian Councils with regard to working in partnership for the Mynydd Parys 250 project. Gordon Warren and Mike Roberts are liaising with #Caru Amlwch with regard to the application for lottery funding. Kevin Ellis noted that the deadline for the lottery application is November, agreed to include the item on the agenda for the September meeting; Mike Roberts to look at the Council's obligations and prepare a report for the Council.*

*Work has been completed at Lon Wen Park in the Port, quotes were obtained and the work commissioned and completed as a matter of urgency due to health and safety concerns. Mike Roberts gave an overview of discussions with #Caru Amlwch with regard to the proposed play equipment at Craig y Don.*

*With regard to a possible grant for play equipment at Maes Mona, concern has been raised by a local resident, however there is overwhelming support from others. It was proposed that the area is designated a 'pre-teen' park.*

*Meg Roberts asked for an update with regard to benches at the creek; the matter of land ownership and responsibility has been discussed between Mike Roberts and the clerk.*

*Mike Roberts has met with the grass cutting contractor; littering and fly tipping are on-going issues; a tree surgeon has visited Trehinion to assess the fallen trees, any risk is minimal.*

## **9 Wylfa Newydd**

Cafwyd crynodeb o'r sefyllfa bresennol yn ymwneud a datblygiad Wylfa Newydd. Mae pryderon a

diffyg gwybodaeth yn parhau ynglyn ag:

- Diffiniad Horizon o gyflogaeth 'lleol'. Nododd Myrddin Owens bod Horizon wedi gaddo byddai 22% o'r gweithwyr ar y safle yn 'lleol' h.y. Caer/Queensferry!
- Gwelliannau i'r lon o Burwen i Gemaes – pwysig cydnabod y nifer o farwolaethau.
- Llety i 4000 o weithwyr dros dro ar y safle
- Llety/Tai i'w rhentu yng Nghaergybi ac nid ochr yma i'r ynys
- Horizon ddim yn cydnabod ymatebion i ymgynghoriad PAC 2 a 3
- Sefyllfa Safle Rhosgoch a pholisiau cynllunio
- Pryder am ddiffyg gwybodaeth ar gael gan Horizon
- Datganiad Partneriaeth Cynghorau Gogledd Mon i'r Arolygwr Cynllunio; bydd datganiad i'r wasg i ddilyn.
- Pam nad oes buddsoddiad yn Ngogledd Ddwyrain Mon? Mae angen etifeddiaeth a buddsoddiad!

Cynnigwyd bod y Cyngor Tref yn cefnogi datganiadau a bwriad Partneriaeth Cynghorau Gogledd Mon i ysgrifennu at yr Arolygwr Cynllunio to godi ymwybyddiaeth am eu pryderon yn ymwneud a'r diffyg gwybodaeth ar gael gan Horizon. Roedd yr aelodau yn cefnogi'n unfrydol.

Nododd Gareth Roberts longyfarchiadau i Bleddyn Mon (Llaneilian) ar ei lwyddiant rhyngwladol yn hwylio yn ddiweddar. CYtuno anfon llythyr i'w longyfarch.

*A summary was given of the current position with regard to the Wylfa Newydd development. There are still ongoing concerns and lack of information with regard to:*

- *Horizon's definition of 'local' employment; Myrddin Owens noted that Horizon had promised 22% of workers onsite would be 'local', i.e. Chester/Queensferry!*
- *Road improvements Burwen to Cemaes – important to acknowledge the number of fatalities*
- *4000 temporary workers' accommodation on site*
- *Rented accommodation/housing in Holyhead not on this side of the island*
- *Horizon not taking into account PAC 2 and 3 consultation responses*
- *Position of Rhosgoch site with regard to planning policy*
- *Concern lack of information forthcoming from Horizon*
- *North Anglesey Councils Partnership statement to planning inspectorate; press statement also to come.*
- *Why is there no investment in NE Anglesey? Legacy and investment needed!*

*Proposed that the Town Council support the statements and intention of the North Anglesey Councils Partnership to write to the Planning Inspectorate to voice concern regarding the lack of information available from Horizon. Members were unanimous in support.*

*Gareth Roberts congratulated Bleddyn Mon (Llaneilian) on his recent international sailing achievements. Agreed to send a letter of congratulations.*

## **10 Gohebiaeth / Correspondence**

### **10.1 Cynllunio/Planning**

Nodwyd penderfyniadau cynllunio CSYM fel a ganlyn –  
*IACC planning decisions were noted as follows –*

- *3 Uwch y Dre, Penbonc – Caniatad/Granted*
- *Rehau – Gwrthod/Refused*

Nododd aelodau eu siom nad oedd diwydiant lleol wedi cael cefnogaeth; roedd caniatad wedi ei wrthod o ganlyniad i risg llifogydd. Nodwyd mai storfa dros dro fyddai dan ddwr ac nid tai. Nid oedd Aelodau yn cofio'r ardal yma dan ddwr erioed. Nodwyd mai'r Cynllun Datblygu Lleol ar y Cyd (Gwynedd a Mon) oedd y polisi cynllunio cyfredol, ac mai Gwynedd oedd wedi arwain ar ddatblygu a gweithredu'r ddogfen. Gofynnwyd a oedd unrhyw aelodau o Bwyllgor Cynllunio CSYM wedi bod ynghlwm a'r gwaith. Aled Jones i wneud ymholiadau pellach.

*Members noted disappointment that a local industry had not been supported; planning had been refused due to potential flood risk. It was noted that it would be temporary storage that would flood not housing; Members didn't ever recall the area flooding. It was noted that current planning policy was the Joint Local Development Plan (Gwynedd and Mon) and that*

*Gwynedd had led on the development and implementation of the document. It was asked whether IACC Planning Committee had had any involvement. Aled Jones to make further enquiries.*

### **11.1 Cyngor Maethu/Fostering Council**
