1 Croeso ac Ymddiheuriadau/Welcome and Apologies

Cadeiriwyd y cyfarfod gan Liz Wood ac fe groesawyd pawb a oedd yn bresennol. Cyn cychwyn ar waith y cyfarfod bu iddi gyfeirio bod y cynlluniau ar gyfer y meysydd chwarae (prosiect loteri) i'w gweld yn y corridor os oedd unrhyw un eisiau gweld yr offer mewn manylder. Gofynwyd i Nia Edwards fod yn bresennol i ateb unrhyw gwestiynau a rhoi eglurhad petai angen.

The meeting was chaired by Liz Wood and all present were welcomed. Before the meeting proper commenced, she noted that the proposals for the play areas (lottery project) were on display in the corridor if anyone wanted to see the equipment in detail. Nia Edwards had been asked to attend to answer any questions and provide explanations if required.

2 Datgan Diddordeb/Declaration of Interest

Myrddin Owens – cais am arian gan Clwb y Gorlan *request for funding.*

3 Cyn Glerc y Cyngor / Former Council Clerk

Crybwyllwyd bod Mr John Sage Hughes, cyn glerc y cyngor am nifer o flynyddoedd wedi marw yn ddiweddar. Ar gynnig Gareth Roberts cytunwyd i ysgrifennu llythyr at ei deulu yn cyfleu cydymdeimlad yr aelodau.

It was noted that Mr John Sage Hughes, a former clerk of the council for many years had recently passed away. It was agreed on Gareth Roberts' proposal to write a letter expressing the members' sympathy to his family.

4 Cofnodion y cyfarfod diwethaf/Minutes of the last meeting

Cymeradwywyd cofnodion y cyfarfod diwethaf. Cynnig Gordon Warren, eilio John Byast. *Minutes of the last meeting were approved. Proposed by Gordon Warren, seconded John Byast.*

5 Materion yn codi / Matters Arising

5.1 Parcio ger yr Ysgol / Parking by the School (4.6)

Roedd yr aelodau yn siomedig gydag ymateb CSYM. Tybed a oedd angen i blentyn gael ei frifo cyn i unrhyw beth gael ei wneud? Dywedodd Richard Jones bod CSYM eisoes yn galluogi parcio am ddim yn ystod danfon a nol plant o'r ysgol. Nodwyd y gallai'r heddlu orfodi y llinellau melyn dwbl. Dywedodd Aled Morris Jones ei fod yn cyfarfod gyda swyddogion priffyrdd a'r deilydd portffolio ac y byddai'n dwyn y mater i'w sylw.

Cynigiwyd bod yr ysgol yn anfon llythyr at yr holl rieni fel a wnaed yn y gorffennol. Cynigiwyd hefyd y dylid anfon llythyr oddi wrth y cyngor tref i'r adran priffyrdd i gefnogi'r ysgol gan ofyn bod y wardeiniad parcio yn galw heibio'r safle yn rheolaidd. Awgrymwyd bod llythyrau gan y cyngor tref yn cael eu dosbarthu i rieni yn tynnu sylw at y broblem a'u pryderon. Mae'n bosibl bod gan GSYM daflen statudol y gellid ei dosbarthu yn ogystal.

Members were disappointed with the response from IACC. Did a child need to be hurt before any action was taken? Richard Jones noted that IACC were already offering free parking at School drop off and pick up times. It was noted that the police could enforce the double yellow lines. Aled Morris Jones noted that he was meeting with highways officers and the portfolio holder and would bring the matter to their attention.

It was proposed that a letter be sent from the school to all parents as has happened in the past. It was also proposed that a letter be sent from the town council to the highways department in support of the school and asking that the parking wardens visit on a regular basis. It was suggested that letters from the town council be distributed to parents highlighting the issue and concerns. IACC may have a statutory leaflet that could also be distributed.

5.2 Croesfan ger yr Ysgol / School Crossing

Derbyniwyd eost mewn perthynas â'r gwasanaeth helpu plant i groesi'r ffordd i'r ysgol. Cytunwyd i anfon cais Rhybudd am Wybodaeth i gael gwybod am y rhesymeg dros y penderfyniad a'r asesiad a oedd ynghlwm â hynny. Cynigiwyd gan Meg Roberts ac eiliwyd gan Mike Roberts. 6 aelod o blaid, neb yn erbyn gyda 5 yn atal eu pleidlais.

An email was received with regard to school crossing patrol. It was agreed to submit an FOI request for the rationale and assessment presented for the decision. Proposed by Meg Roberts, seconded Mike Roberts. 6 members in favour, 0 members against, 5 members abstained.

5.3 Priffyrdd / Highways (4.7)

Nid oedd diweddariad mewn perthynas â'r cyfyngiadau parcio a phaentio arwyddion ar y ffordd. Dywedodd Richard Jones ei fod dan yr argraff bod y mater yn nwylo'r adran gynllunio. Gofynnodd Meg Roberts os oedd unrhyw ddiweddariad ar y cyrbau wedi eu gollwng a ofynwyd amdanynt yn Stryd Mona a ger y Neuadd Goffa. Aled Morris Jones i gysylltu gyda'r swyddogion priodol i gael diweddariad.

No update regarding the parking restrictions and painting of road markings. Richard Jones noted that he understood the matter to be with the planning department. Meg Roberts asked whether there was any update regarding the dropped kerbs requested in Mona Street and by the Memorial Hall. Aled Morris Jones to contact the relevant officers for an update.

5.4 Gwasanaeth Bws / Bus Service (4.4)

Roedd eost o GSYM yn cadarnhau arbediad o £5.9K trwy atal y gwasanaeth bws rhif 32 o Amlwch i Langefni. Gofynwyd os oedd modd i'r cynghorwyr sir wneud rhywbeth i ail-sefydlu'r gwasanaeth gan ei fod yn bwysig bod pobl lleol yn cael gwasanaeth yn ystod yr amser lle mae pobl yn teithio i'w gwaith. Nodwyd bod Richard Griffiths eisoes wedi cadarnhau iddo bleidleisio o blaid cynnydd yn nhreth y cyngor o 9.5%. Dywedodd Richard Jones nad oedd yn bresennol ond petai, mi fyddai yntau wedi pleidleisio o blaid y cynnydd o 9.5%. Nid oedd diweddariad wedi dod i law gan Rhun ap Iorwerth mewn perthynas â'r gwasanaeth bws.

An email from IACC confirms that a saving of £5.9k was made by withdrawing the 32 bus from Amlwch to Langefni. It was asked whether the county councillors could do anything to reinstate the service as it is important to local people to have a service operating at commuting times for work. It was noted that Richard Griffiths had already confirmed that he had voted in favour of the 9.5% increase in council rates; Richard Jones stated that he had not been present but would have also voted in favour of the the 9.5% increase. There is no update from Rhun ap Iorwerth with regard to the bus service as yet.

5.5 Marchnad Amlwch Market (12)

Roedd eost gan adran trwyddedu CSYM yn datgan bod y farchnad yn cael ei rheoli gan ddeilydd y

drwydded. Cytunwyd yn unfrydol i anfon cais rhyddid gwybodaeth am gopi o'r cytundeb ac i gael cadarnhad pwy a gytunodd bod un person yn cael rheolaeth lwydros dros y farchnad a'r rhesymau dros y penderfyniad hwnnw.

An email from IACC licensing department noted that the the market is controlled by the licensee. It was unanimously agreed to submit an FOI request for a copy of the contract and to confirm who had agreed to one person having total control over the market and the rationale for the decision.

5.6 Tir tu cefn i Lucky House / Land behind Lucky House (16.3)

Roedd Cymdeithas Tai Clwyd Alun wedi darparu gwybodaeth bellach. Nodwyd y bydd yr adroddiadau a'r gwaith archwilio yn cael eu rhannu maes o law fel rhan o'r cais cynllunio. Gofynnodd yr aelodau am gopi o'r adroddiad ecolegol a pha bryd y byddai'r gwaith yn cael ei wneud. Gwnaed sylw bod na waith sylweddol wedi ei wneud i glirio'r safle a bod y cynefinoedd wedi cael eu distrywio. Cytunwyd i gysylltu'r gyda'r sefydliad eto i ofyn pa bryd gafodd yr arolygon ecolegol eu cyflawni ac am gael copiau o'r adroddiadau wedi eu hanfon cyn gynted â phosibl.

Further information has been provided by Clwyd Alun Housing Association. It is noted that the reports and investigation work will be shared as part of the planning application in due course. Members asked for a copy of the ecological report and when the work was undertaken. It was noted that there has been significant land clearance and the habitat has been destroyed. Agreed to contact the organisation again asking when had the ecological surveys been completed and for copies of the reports to be forwarded as soon as possible.

5.7 Polisi Gosod Tai / Housing Allocation Policy (16.6)

Roedd yr eitem eisoes ar yr agenda.

5.8 Cwyn i'r Ombwdsmon / Complaint to the Ombudsman (6)

Cytunwyd yn y cyfarfod diwethaf i ddwyn y mater hwn i ben.
It had been agreed at the last meeting not to pursue the matter further.

6 Pwyllgorau Allanol / External Meetings

6.1 Fforwm Cyswllt / Liaison Forum

Rhododd Gordon Warren adroddiad yn dilyn cyfarfod lle trafodwyd adolygiad y comisiwn ffiniau a'r polisi gosod tai. Caiff yr adolygiad comisiwn ffiniau ei gynnwys ar agenda cyfarfod mis Medi y cyngor.

Gordon Warren gave a report following the meeting where the boundary commission review and the housing allocation policy had been discussed. The boundary commission review is to be included on the agenda for the town council's September meeting.

6.2 Rhun ap Iorwerth

Rhododd crynodeb o'r cyfarfod gan Liz Wood a Carys Hughes. Cytunwyd i ysgrifennu at Rhun ap Iorwerth i ofyn iddo geisio trefnu cyfarfod o gynrychiolwyr y cyngor tref gyda'r gweinidogion perthnasol yng Nghaerdydd.

Trafodwyd y cyllid o £495K o'r NDA a chytunwyd i ysgrifennu at GSYM i ofyn bod y cyngor tref yn cael ei gynrychioli ar y bwrdd/panel. Diolchodd Gareth Roberts i Aled Jones am ei waith gyda'r NDA i sicrhau cyllid ar gyfer yr ardal. Dywedodd Aled Jones y byddai arian pellach ar gael trwy GSYM a fyddai'n cyfateb cyfraniad yr NDA. Dywedodd y byddai Dylan Williams (adran economaidd) yn cyfarfod yn fuan gyda Chyngor Cymuned Llanbadrig i drafod prosiectau posibl. Cytunwyd ei fod hefyd yn cyfarfod gyda'r cyngor tref.

An overview of the meeting was given by Liz Wood and Carys Hughes. It was agreed to write to Rhun ap Iorwerth to ask that he try to arrange a meeting for representatives of the town council with the relevant ministers in Cardiff.

The NDA funding (£495k) was discussed and it was agreed to write to IACC to ask that the town council is represented on the board/panel. Gareth Roberts thanked Aled Jones for his work with the NDA to secure the funding for the area. Aled Jones noted that further funding was being made

available by IACC to match the NDA's contribution. He noted that Dylan Williams (economic development) will soon be meeting with Llanbadrig Community Council to discuss possible projects, it was agreed that he should also meet with the town council.

7 Pwyllgor Cyllid / Finance Committee

Gadawodd aelodau'r cyhoedd yr ystafell tra bu i Myrddin Owens roi crynodeb o gyfarfod o'r pwyllgor cyllid. Dywedwyd bod y pwyllgor wedi cyfarfod i drafod tendrau y prosiect loteri yn ogystal â chyfarfod misol arferol y pwyllgor. Cafodd yr aelodau wybod sut y bu i bwyllgor y prosiect ystyried a sgorio'r tendrau a ddaeth i lawr ar gyfer datblygiad y meysydd chwarae. Bu i'r pwyllgor cyllid gyfarfod wedyn i ystyried argymhellion y pwyllgor prosiect. Ar ôl ystyried rheoliadau a gweithdrefnau ariannol y cyngor cytunwyd mai priodol fyddai cynnig y cytundeb ar gyfer y ddau faes chwarae i Kompan/Sunshine Playground, a hynny yn amodol ar sêl bendith y cyngor. Cytunwyd yn unfrydol i dderbyn yr argymhelliad. Dywedwyd bod y loteri yn hapus i gamera CCTV gael ei gynnwys yng nghostau'r prosiect os oedd y prosiect yn brin o arian. Cynigiwyd bod y cyngor tref yn talu os nad oedd digon o bres. Nid oedd gwrthwynebiad a rhoddwyd yr hawl i weithredu i'r pwyllgor cyllid.

Daeth cais am arian i law gan Glwb y Gorlan ar gyfer gwaith adeiladu. Ar ôl ystyried yr wybodaeth a ddaeth i law, penderfynwyd cyfrannu swm o £1000. Nid oedd gwrthwynebiad.

Daeth cais am arian i law gan Grŵp Anglesey First Response. Mae'r sefydliad yn cefnogi y gwasanaeth ambiwlans. Roedd y pwyllgor cyllid o'r farn y byddai'r grŵp yn elwa o gael cefnogaeth y cyngor tref ond nid oedd y cais yn cyd-fynd gyda'r meini prawf ar gyfer cael cymorth ariannol gan ei fod yn sefydliad a oedd yn gwasanaethu yr ynys i gyd. Cytunwyd i estyn gwahoddiad i gynrychiolydd i fynychu cyfarfod nesaf y pwyllgor cyllid i drafod hyn ymhellach. Cytunodd y cyngor i roi hawl i weithredu i'r pwyllgor cyllid petai angen i wneud cyfraniad teg.

Members of the public left the meeting room whilst Myrddin Owens gave a summary of the finance committee meetings. It was noted that the committee had met to discuss the lottery project tenders as well as the ordinary monthly meeting. Members were informed how the project committee had considered and scored the proposals received for the play area development. The finance committee had then met to consider the project committee's recommendation. Taking into account the council's financial regulations and procedures, it was justified and agreed to offer Kompan/Sunshine Playgrounds the contract for both play areas pending full council approval. It was unanimously agreed to accept the recommendation. It was noted that the lottery were happy for a CCTV camera to be included in the project cost, should there be any shortfall in funding, it was proposed that the town council meet that shortfall. There was no objection and the finance committee given power to act.

A request for funding was received from Clwb y Gorlan towards building improvements. Having considered the information provided, the committee proposed a contribution of £1000. There was no objection.

A request for funding was received from the Anglesey First Response group. The organisation supports the ambulance service. The finance committee felt that the group would benefit from the town council's support but the request did not satisfy the criteria for financial support as it was an island wide organisation. Agreed to invite a representative to attend the next finance committee meeting to discuss further. Full council agreed that the finance committee have power to act to contribute fairly.

8 Adroddiad Pwyllgor Parciau a Mannau Agored / Parks and Open Spaces Committee Report

Dyweddodd Mike Roberts bod y cyfarfod wedi mynd rhagddo yn ei absenoldeb a bod Julie Hughes wedi ei gadeirio. Roedd yn siomedig y gofynwyd i Gordon Warren adael y cyfarfod gan bod ganddo wybodaeth i'w gyfleu yn ôl i'r cyfarfod. Bu i Mike Roberts gadarnhau pwy oedd aelodau'r pwyllgor gan egluro yr anhawster o gael cworwm yn bresennol fel bod y pwyllgor yn gallu cario ymlaen. Caed pleidlais dros gael Gordon Warren yn aelod o'r pwyllgor; o blaid 4, yn erbyn 5, atal eu pleidlais 3.

Rhoddodd Julie Hughes grynoded o'r cyfarfod. Nodwyd bod y pwyllgor yn hapus i dalu premiwm am rent maes chwarae Maes Llwyn dros gyfnod y brydles. Nodwyd na fyddai Myrddin Owens

bellach yn gofalu am y brydles ar ran y Cyngor. Diolchodd Gareth Roberts i Myrddin Owens am ei waith ar ran y Cyngor am nifer o flynyddoedd a hynny heb gost i'r Cyngor. Mae'n hanfodol cael cyngor cyfreithiol mewn perthynas â dogfennau cyfreithiol i ddiogelu'r Cyngor a'i aelodau. Cytunwyd bod y Clerc yn mynd â'r brydles i TR Evans a'i Gwmni gan mai nhw yw'r unig swyddfa cyfreithwyr yn Amlwch.

Mike Roberts noted that the meeting had gone ahead in his absence and that Julie Hughes had chaired the meeting. He was disappointed that Gordon Warren had been asked to leave the meeting when he had items to report back to the committee. Mike Roberts confirmed who the members of the committee were and explained the difficulty to get a quorum present to be able to meet as a committee. A vote was taken for Gordon Warren to join the committee; in favour 4, against 5, abstained 3.

Julie Hughes gave an overview of the meeting. It was noted that the committee was happy to pay a one off premium for the rent of Maes Llwyn play area for the duration of the lease. It was noted that Myrddin Owens would no longer be looking at the lease on behalf of the Council. Gareth Roberts thanked Myrddin Owens for his work on behalf of the Council over many years, at no cost to the Council. It is essential that advice is sought regarding legal documents in order to safeguard the Council and its members. Agreed that the clerk take the lease documents to TR Evans and Co, being the only solicitors' office in Amlwch.

9 Adroddiad Pwyllgor Cynllunio / Planning Committee Report

Dywedwyd bod dau gais wedi dod i law ers y cyfarfod diwethaf ond nid oedd unrhyw sylwadau wedi cael eu cyflwyno hyd yma.

It was noted that two applications had been received since the last meeting, but no observations had been submitted as yet.

10 Prosiect Loteri/Lottery Project

Caed diweddariad eisoes fel rhan o adroddiad y pwyllgor cyllid.

An update had already been given as part of the finance committee report.

11 Wylfa Newydd

Rhoddodd Aled Morris Jones drosolwg o'r sefyllfa bresennol mewn perthynas â llywodraeth y DU. Bydd canlyniad y cais DCO yn hysbys ar 23/10/2019.

Aled Morris Jones gave an overview of the current situation with regard to the UK government. The outcome of the DCO application is due 23/10/2019.

12 Safle Rehau Site

Diolchwyd i Aled Morris Jones am ei lythyr i Gaerdydd a'r ebost dilynol a ddaeth fel ymateb oddi wrth Ken Skates y Gweinidog. Roedd Gareth Roberts o'r farn y dylid rhoi pwysau ar Lywodraeth Cymru i brynu'r safle. Roedd yn bosibl darparu hyd at 20 o unedau busnes a fyddai'n cefnogi cwmnïau lleol a chreu cyfleon gwaith. Roedd Gareth Roberts yn gobeithio y byddai CSYM yn gefnogol i brynu'r safle a'r cyfleon posibl a fyddai'n dod i Ogledd Môn.

Aled Morris Jones was thanked for his letter to Cardiff and the subsequent email response from the Minister Ken Skates. Gareth Roberts felt that pressure should be put on the Welsh Government to purchase the site. It would be possible to provide up to 20 business units therefore supporting local firms and providing local employment opportunities. Gareth Roberts hoped that IACC would be supportive of the purchase of the site and the potential opportunities for North Anglesey.

13 Adolygu cyfrifoldebau a dylestwyddau Cadeirydd y Cyngor / Review the roles and responsibilities of the Chair of Council

Rhoddodd Myrddin Owens gyflwyniad ar rôl a chyfrifoldebau'r Cadeirydd. Cytunwyd bod dogfennau Un Llais Cymru ar 'rôl y cadeirydd' a 'bod yn gynghorydd' yn cael eu cynnwys efo'r cofnodion a'u dosbarthu i'r aelodau.

Myrddin Owens gave a brief on the roles and responsibilities of the Chair. It was agreed to include the relevant One Voice Wales papers on 'the role of the chairman' and 'being a councillor' with the

minutes when distributed to members.

14 Ymgynghoriad – Polisi Gosod Tai CSYM / Consultation – IACC Policy on Housing Allocation

Roedd yr aelodau wedi synnu bod angen ymgynghori o gwbl a ddylai cyswllt lleol gael ei ystyried wrth osod tai cyffredin. Teimlai'r aelodau yn gryf y dylai pobl lleol wedi byw yn yr ardal, gyda theulu agos yn yr ardal, neu wedi gweithio yn yr ardal am gynod o bum mlynedd neu fwy gael blaenoriaeth wrth osod ty. Teimlai Gareth Roberts dylid hefyd ystyried y diffiniad o 'lleol' wrth ddechrau gyda'r gymuned ei hun cyn ystyried y ward etholiadol ac yna'r sir h.y. blaenioraethu pobl Amlwch, yna Twrcelyn ac yna Ynys Mon. Pawb yn cytuno, mae pwysigrwydd cymuned a chefnogaeth teulu a ffrindiau yn amfrisiadwy, ac mae nifer o bobl yn dibynnu ar y gefnogaeth yma yn eu bywyd pob dydd.

The members were surprised that there was a need to consult at all in relation to whether a local contact was required when letting houses. The members felt strongly that local people who had lived in the area, or who had close family in the area, or who had worked in the area for five years or more, should have priority when letting a house. Gareth Roberts was also of the opinion that the definition of 'local' should be considered starting with the community itself before the electoral ward and then the whole of the county i.e. prioritising the people of Amlwch, then Twrcelyn and finally Anglesey. Everyone agreed and that the importance of community and the support of family and friends was priceless as a number of people depended on this support in their daily lives.

15 Cwestiynau i'r Cynghorwyr Sirol/Questions to the County Councillors

16 Gohebiaeth / Correspondence

- 16.1** CCTV – ebost gan PCSO Nerys Williams yn gofyn i'r cyngor ystyried camerau ychwanegol mewn lleoliadau penodol. Y clerch i gysylltu gyda'r cwmni sy'n eu gosod i weld a fyddai hyn yn bosibl a beth fyddai'r gost.

CCTV – an email from PCSO Nerys Williams asking the council to consider additional cameras at specific locations. The clerk to contact the installation company to see whether this would be possible and at what cost.

- 16.2** Ymgynghoriad Ysgolion – Mae CSYM wedi datgan nad oedd costau ychwanegol i'r ymgynghoriad. Nodwyd os oedd staff yn gweithio ar yr ymgynghoriad yna nid oeddynt yn gweithio ar agweddau eraill o'u swyddi. Nodwyd bod Dr Gwynne Jones wedi gwrthod cyfarfod gyda llywodraethwyr yr ysgolion a'r cynghorau cymuned. Cytunwyd i anfon cais rhyddid gwybodaeth o ran y costau llawn gan gynnwys manylion staffio.

Schools Consultation – IACC have stated that there was no additional cost for the consultation. It was noted that whilst staff were working on the consultation, they weren't working on other aspects of their job roles. It was noted that Dr Gwynne Jones had refused to meet with school governors and community councils. Agreed to submit an FOI request for their full costs including staffing breakdown.

- 16.3** Roedd Grwp Hanes y Llan wedi ysgrifennu i godi ymwybyddiaeth o'r ffaith bod enwau traddodiadol a hanesyddol Cymraeg ar dai ac eiddo yn yr ardal yn diflannu. Cytunwyd i ysgrifennu at Gomisiynydd y Gymraeg a CSYM i godi ymwybyddiaeth o'r broblem gan ofyn am gefnogaeth cynghorau lleol.

Grwp Hanes y Llan have written to raise awareness about the loss of traditional and historical Welsh names on houses and properties in the area. Agreed to write to the Welsh Language Commissioner and IACC to raise awareness of the problem, and ask local councils for support.

17 Unrhyw Fater Arall/Any Other Business

17.1 Lon Las Mon
